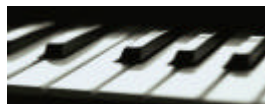

## **MESSAGE FROM SYDNEY WATER**

Please note we have listened to feedback from residents and in consideration of their concerns have reviewed our decision as follows:

The work will now be carried out between Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September and December 2007, and between May and June 2008, weather and tides permitting.

Pedestrians will now have access to the walking track at all times during the work. However, between 7am and 5.30pm, Monday to Saturday, Sydney Water staff will escort pedestrians through the work site and across the footbridge, as required.

Be aware that this is a working construction site.

For their own safety, pedestrians are advised

NOT to attempt to pass through the site unescorted during construction hours. Pedestrians will not be permitted through the site unescorted.
