Tuesdays – FUN AND GAMES Different activities each week, incl. basketball, soccer, poison ball, board games and much more.

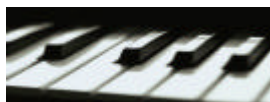
Wednesdays – TENNIS and BEACH SPORTS with professional coach Jenny Burrows.
